2004 - 2006 Highlights

Athlete Participation and Accomplishments

- * Selected a National Team for 2005-06 and 2006-07
- * Held the 2005 National Championships and crowned new Champions (Victoria Muniz – Junior Lady and Natalie Lyman- Novice Lady)
- * Puerto Rico's first international competitor (Victoria Muniz) competed in Copenhagen, Denmark in March where she placed 7th in a field of 18 skaters. She also competed in Sofia, Bulgaria in October for a 10th place showing
- * Sent Victoria Muniz to Junior Grand Prix Final
- * Diana Reina skated an exhibition at Detroit's Campus Martius during the week of Christmas, 2005
- * Sent athletes to training seminars
- * One athlete selected for a Coca-Cola commercial and stipend.

Development Activities

- * Implemented three (3) seminar and shows in Puerto Rico
 - a. Produced a figure skating exhibition at the Plaza de Caribe en Ponce, Puerto Rico featuring: Surya Bonaly, Victoria Muniz, Abigail Guerrero, and Jasmine Lopez.
